GOOD MORNING,

As I prepared to make a quick trip out to Lubbock this last Thursday I started think back to a time in my life when I was making that trip 2 to 4 times a week. It became such a routine that it was like the car knew how to get there on its own. Many of us get that way about driving places we visit frequently. In fact, we get so used to driving, we begin to multi-task while behind the wheel. People eat entire meals, put on makeup, and I have even seen people reading newspapers and novels while driving their cars. I remember one time on my way to Lubbock, I even saw someone painting their fingernails. It is always interesting to watch our teenagers as they learn to drive. Their approach to driving is so different than someone who has been driving a long time. They approach it with fear, anticipation, and respect. They try to make up for their inexperience with being extremely careful. At least this how most of them approach driving.

Our worship service and even the communion service get treated a lot like driving a familiar route. Many of us have been doing them so long we have lost some of the fear and respect we should have. Like an experienced driver, one who has been attending church services for a long time might find themselves multi-tasking. Instead of giving our sole focus to praising God, remembering His Son, and studying God's will for us, we find ourselves thinking about school, jobs, and other things we need to get done. We might even be guilty of jotting down a "to do list" in the middle of services. I know many of us (myself included) need to take a step back and approach meeting together in the presence of God with the fear, anticipation, and the respect it deserves. Do not let the worship service become a habit or routine. Instead allow it to be the communion with God and one another it is supposed to be.
