## SPEEDING THROUGH LIFE

If you have ever driven down the Winters freeway (speedway), you've likely seen these little signs with numbers on them. Some places it's 60 mph and sometimes it's 70mph. During our thirty-minute rush hours in the morning or evening, it appears those numbers can be flexible depending on what the individual believes they mean. What does the law think they mean? Just wait for the "red and blue" to find out. God's laws aren't flexible depending on our, or society's, agreement. No, God's laws are immutable. There seems to be a growing body of thought in today's world that individual desires trump laws. This may include God's laws too. We, as Christians, believe that God's laws are sacred. Our Brother Jesus told us in Matthew 5:16-18 that He came to fulfill the Law, not abolish it. Jesus spent a lot of time in what's called the Sermon on the Mount telling how we are to follow God's Law more fully. Romans 7:7-8 tells us the purpose of the Laws. Are God's Law in conflict with Man's laws. No, but we are given an example of how to distinguish them in Acts 5:27-32. How should we, as Christians, work it out? Titus 3:1-5 encourages us to obey those governments over us and Romans 13 tells us why. Given the changes occurring in our world, that seems an impossible task. Not really. Jesus gave us the top two in Matthew 22:37-40. Romans 1 and First Corinthians 6:9-11 gives a good base line of what is acceptable and what isn't. How can we, as Jude tells us, "... contend earnestly for the Faith"? Read on down to 16-24 to find out. Titus 3:8-9 further helps us in presenting God's laws in a Christian manner. Second Timothy 4:1-4 and First Peter 3:13-17 tells us to be ready to tell others about our faith in Christ. In today's world, things appear to have an attitude of "anything goes" and "don't judge me". We are not the Judge, but we are His messengers. We can only relate what God's desire for the world is.
