MY DAD BUILT THESE **CANONS**

I remember years ago visiting a castle in Germany. On the path to the entrance there were enormous cannons. probably 400 years old, guarding the front of the castle. A group of German children were playing on the cannons, straddling them, and having a great time thinking about what it must have been like "back then." I overheard their conversation to be a typical one among children: "My dad is better than your dad." The rhetoric got more and more intense as they shouted out, "My dad is the strongest," or "My dad built our house," or even "My dad is president of a bank." One small boy listened intently, obviously not sure how to get into the dad competition. Finally, he shouted out, "well, my dad . . . uh . . . my dad made these canons!"

Funny isn't it, how important it seems to be that we are bigger, better, and stronger than others? This kind of thinking often even enters our spiritual thinking. We may think we have all the answers. We may think we are somehow more spiritual than the next person. We may consider ourselves strong spiritually. Such thinking often means that we "look down" on those we consider to be weaker spiritually. The apostle Paul dealt with this issue when writing to the Roman church in chapters 14-15. He said it this way: "Accept the one whose faith is weak, without quarreling over disputable matters."

In the context, Paul stresses the dangers of judging others, or of "pigeonholing" our brothers and sisters. The dangers go far beyond causing offense. When we cause a brother or sister to stumble or cause them to do something that their conscience tells them is wrong, we have contributed to their sin. Paul goes on to say that we might even cause them to fall or as he says it, "be destroyed."

The admonition to us is clear in 14:19 "Let us make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification."

Our relationships with one another should have that goal of working peace in the body and of building one another up in love!
