"HOPE DOES NOT PUT US TO SHAME ..."

Hope is something that should lift us up but that can often be something devastating. I mean, we hope for so many things in this life. "I hope I get this job!" "I hope I get an 'A' on my test!" "I hope she says yes!," and "I hope that the stock market doesn't crash!" The list of things we hope for is long. So often, we have seen those hopes dashed by the realities of the world we live in. How often have we crashed beneath the weight of unrealized dreams, painful disappointments, and shattered hopes? How often have our great "hopes" become something we would rather forget, something dead and gone?

But the Bible talks of a different kind of hope, a hope that "does not put us to shame" (Romans 5:5). Could there really be such a thing? Peter, writing to scattered Christians who were experiencing all manner of troubles and seeming failures in their lives, shares the very thing that enabled him to endure whatever life threw at him. Beginning in 1 Peter 1:3, Peter is "bursting at the seams" as he expresses his reasons for giving God praise. "In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead." In other words, our hope remains as alive as Jesus Christ!

Yes, sometimes life will throw us a curve ball or two. People will fail us. We will be oppressed (or depressed) by our work situation. We may be troubled by financial woes. We may be rejected or offended by others. We may see all that we own be destroyed by storms. But in all that, we serve a living Jesus who continues to give us hope that cannot disappoint. As long as he lives (and he has overcome death, he cannot die again), our hope lives with him!
