A HAPPY HEART DOES WHAT?

Where is the happiness and the joy? What happened to it? Where did it go? Who stole the joy? Who ripped off everyone's happiness? How come the church is seen as somber and rigid, without a sense of humor? When where laughter, happiness and joy stolen out of the church and out of the lives of many Christians'?

We have too many "Grumpy Old Christians" in the church. Who stole their joy? How come they don't laugh? How come they don't split a gut and bellow out with expressions of joy? Turning ninety-five, comedian Bob Hope told TV guide the secret to his longevity: "Laughter is it. Laughter is therapy-an instant vacation.

Happiness is a choice in life and Jesus desires us to be dispensers of joy. When we have the "Be Happy Attitude" life is fun and not ho-hum.

The word tells us this about joy: **A happy heart makes the face cheerful, but heartache crushes the spirit.** (Proverbs 15:13) Happiness is the key to succeeding in this life. It's what makes life worth living. It's the smile from the little one you help each day. It's the "thank you" from others for helping them out. It's the one who rejoices in the traffic jam and looks at it as a time to spend in prayer with the Lord.

All of this makes it easier and delightful to go through the day. All "the days of the oppressed are wretched, but the cheerful heart has a continual feast." (Proverbs 15:15). Have you ever met a person who is so cheerful and bubbly and that is always a pleasure to be around? "A cheerful look brings joy to the heart, and good news gives health to the bones." (Proverbs 15:30). It's a medical fact that laughter and humor are healthy for a body. People who laugh and enjoy life live longer.

Comedian Bob Newhart stated, 'People with a sense of humor tend to be less egocentric. They are more humble in moments of success and less defeated in times of travail.'

"A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones" (Proverbs 17:22). Laughter relieves stress. It reduces aggression and conflict. It relieves anxiety. It's physically impossible to laugh and be afraid simultaneously. Laughter also shrinks our fears. Nehemiah reminds us that "the joy of the Lord is our strength." Your trust in Christ is what brings forth the joy filled life. It's your choice... Be happy or be miserable. Church, let's make a difference!
