ONE PERSON AT A TIME

One of my favorite examples of God acting in this world is in the book of Daniel. In chapter 4, is the story of Nebuchadnezzar's dream and Daniel's interpretation of the dream. A year later, the dream became reality. Nebuchadnezzar was struck with insanity, due to his sinful pride in his own achievements. The Lord restored his mind, but only after he spent a long period of time in a field thinking he was a wild animal (Daniel 4:28-37). Nebuchadnezzar went from boasting, "Is not this great Babylon, that I have built for the glory of my majesty?" (Daniel 4:30 ESV), to a humble prayer: "I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and extol and honor the King of heaven" (Daniel 4:37). He had repented of prideful empire building.

We should be concerned about the same type of empire building in the church today. We can focus on large church buildings and large memberships instead of focusing on ways to build up the lives of people, and then leaving the results to God (1 Corinthians 3:6-7).

When we get off track and devote too much energy and resources to statistics, buildings, and programs, we can become prideful and forget about the needs of God's people.

Jesus never forgot the value of people. He invested his time in many merciful acts for others and building up the 12 men who would carry his work forward (Mark 3:14). Paul taught Timothy, who in turn taught others (2 Timothy 1:13; 2 Timothy 2:2).

So, let's remember that investing in people is the way that the kingdom of God grows. One person at a time, through investment of time, teaching, prayer and love.
