# **NEW LIFE IN A NUTSHELL**

It is Spring time! Thankfully, there have been some beautiful days lately to work outside! Pam and I have cut back the dead plants and planted flowers that should bring us joy for at least a few months. There seems, however, to be one question that keeps coming up...WATER! Are these flowers, shrubs, etc. going to have enough water to continue growing and flourishing in this climate? I know that in the grand scheme of things, our little flowering plants are not making much of a difference other than bringing joy to us and to passersby. How much more important are the farmers who depend on the rain and the sunshine to make things grow so that they can feed their families and possibly hundreds of others?

It is an amazing system isn't it? I mean seeds carry in themselves the possibility of life for hundreds of generations. Watered by the rains, flourishing in the soil those seeds provide for all involved: from the sower to the bread on the table. It eventually accomplishes what God intended for it.

Through the prophet Isaiah, God tells us that His word is exactly like that. It is like a seed that falls to the ground. It is like the rain that provides the moisture necessary for growth. His word will accomplish what he intends it to.

Can you get your brain around that? I am definitely challenged to understand it! I can sow seeds, and I can buy bread at the store but I have no real concept of how the whole system works. Words are powerful...but wow! His words are certainly much higher than my thoughts and His ways far beyond my comprehension.

In all of scripture we see God's plan unfolding. We are privy to the minutest corner of God's thoughts, and you know what? We are in the middle of his plan! His invitation to seek Him while he can be found, to forsake wickedness and unrighteousness and turn to Him shows that he cares how we respond to His message. This is the God who stands ready to give mercy and to freely pardon. What a God!

I recently read about 2000 year-old date seeds that were excavated in Palestine. They were planted and grew into fruit producing date trees whose variety had been extinct for centuries.

In some of our lives, our faith has been like that, lying dormant, ignored, and sometimes useless for years. Isn't it time that we let that soft rain of God's word fall on it and allow that seed to grow. Isn't it time that we seek the Lord and turn to His mercy and pardon that are waiting for us?

As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it." Isaiah 55:10-11
