# **GOOD MORNING**

There is a story of a man took his small son with him to town one day to run some errands. They decided to stop at a busy café for lunch. The father sat down on one of the stools at the counter and lifted the boy up to the seat beside him. They ordered, and when the waiter brought the food, the father said, "Son, since it is so loud and busy in here we'll just have a silent prayer." Dad got through praying first and waited for the boy to finish his prayer, but he just sat with his head bowed for an unusually long time. When he finally looked up, his father asked him, "What in the world were you praying about all that time?" With the innocence and honesty of a child, he replied, "How do I know? It was a silent prayer."

As I go through the curriculum for camp this summer, one of the major themes is prayer. It can be difficult to know how and what to pray about, especially if you are young or new to it. A statement that really influences my understanding of prayer comes from Charles B. Hodge Jr. in a book he wrote. He said, "I don't believe in prayer.... I believe in God; therefore, I pray." Prayer is not some magic list of words we recite that effects the will of God. It should be a heartfelt conversation with our heavenly Father. Even though He knows the hidden things of our heart, we still need to talk to Him. It keeps us feeling connected and reminds of our relationship with Him. So, my encouragement for you this morning is, to spend more time in prayer. Even if its new and awkward, it will get better with time and practice, and your relationship with our heavenly Father will grow.
