A CHRISTIAN RESPONSE TO THE WAR **BETWEEN ISRAEL AND HAMAS**

It is troubling to watch the pictures. The destruction, the death, the hatred that we are witnessing in Palestine right now is enough to move us to tears, and well it should. People are suffering. Children are dying. Homes and livelihoods are being demolished. How should a Christian view the events? Should we take sides? We are, whether we admit it or not, often deeply influenced by the news we watch on TV, or we read on the internet. And as we have seen in our own political situation in the past years, the news station that we rely on most will likely shape our view of what was going on. They will also often cause us to take sides. The terminology that is thrown around, the hatred that is exhibited on news stations or Websites, and even the internet posts by so called "believers" make one wonder whether these people really know Jesus. We are talking about the Jesus who walked some of those very roads and through some of those very cities in Palestine.

What is our Christian "world view"? How do you see your Christian life, your faith in the context of what is going on in our world? Is our world view shaped by the ones who speak the loudest, or show the most pictures? God's word expresses clearly what God's will is for us. Should that not be our view of how we are to live in this world? Whether we look at Micah 6:8 (please read this) or head to the New Testament and the words of Jesus, Matthew 23:23 (please read this), our task is to live lives on this planet that exhibit justice and faithfulness, mercy and love, humility, and kindness.

Lurge you, Christian brothers and sisters, to think deeply about these things. I urge you to pray. I urge you to pray long and hard that instead of focusing on our differences, that we can focus on peace, on love, and on how we can live together in a world that desperately needs to hear the message of Christ.

There is a short message that I would like all of you to take time to read. It is written by Everett Huffard, a Christian brother that I respect more than most. Everett lived much of his life in Palestine. He shared the message of Christ with Jews and non-Jews. No one I know and respect has a better grasp on what it means to be a Christian while watching the goings-on abroad, than this man.
