OPEN EARS TO LISTEN AND HEAR

Two men were in downtown New York City, walking near Times Square. It was during the noon lunch hour and the streets were filled with people. Cars were honking their horns, taxicabs were squealing around corners, sirens were wailing, and the sounds of the city were almost deafening. One man said, "I hear a cricket." His friend said, "What? You couldn't possibly hear a cricket in all this noise!" "No, I'm sure of it," I heard a cricket." He went to a big cement planter where some shrubs were growing.
