### **GOOD MORNING,**

Some of my favorite quotes come from Albert Einstein. He spent his whole life looking for answers not just in the world of science, but also in life and spirituality. I am not sure if he ever found all the answers he was looking for, but one quote that has always stuck with me is some advice he gave to his son in a letter. "Life is like riding a bicycle. To keep your balance, you must keep moving."
