ONE GOAL, MANY PATHS?

It is as common as complaints about the heat in the summer and complaints about the cold in the winter: there may be one goal of heaven, but there are many paths. The “open-minded” laud this idea, the simple-minded accept it, and the carnal-minded embrace it. However, the spiritually minded must challenge it.

The Bible teaches there is one hope (Eph 4:4). Some may hope for nothingness, nirvana, or reincarnation, but the actual future is eternity. Some will spend eternity with God; the rest will spend it without God. One of the saddest verses in the Bible warns, “They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might” (2 Thes 1:9). Many fear the flaming fire, but the genuine horror of hell is the absence of God. Heaven is eternity with God—the one hope.

Are there many ways to attain that hope? Not according to the one who makes hope possible—Jesus. He said there are two paths, but only one leads to eternal life: “Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few” (Matt 7:13-14). At another time he said, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me” (John 14:6).

Jesus makes it clear there is only one way to God, and he is it. Those who sincerely, passionately, and honestly look for other ways must reject Jesus as a liar. Despite their kind hearts and earnest pleas, there is one goal with only one way.
